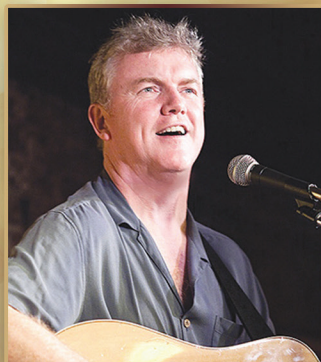

Dublin born **Cíarán Sheehan** is an acclaimed actor, singer, voice healer whose performances have been said to warm the heart and touch the soul. There is an amazing quality to his voice and his ability to capture an audience is nothing short of remarkable. Cíarán has many professional accomplishments to his credit, most notably playing the role of The Phantom in *"The Phantom of The Opera"* for over 1,000 performances on Broadway and in Toronto. But perhaps of more importance than his accomplishments is his sincere desire to use his incredible talents to inspire others to look within themselves to discover their own inner beauty.

Described as possessing a "shimmering soprano" (The New York Times) with "sparkle and precision" (The Washington Post), Connecticut native **Kristen Plumley** has appeared in pops concerts with esteemed orchestras across the United States and Canada such as the Cleveland, Indianapolis, Seattle, Baltimore, St. Louis, Minnesota, Orlando, New Jersey, Edmonton and Ottawa Symphonies, among many others. These concerts have featured the music of Broadway's leading ladies, gems from operettas, and Gilbert and Sullivan favorites. But her favorite is *Sci-Fi Spectacular*, which showcases music from science fiction movies and television shows, hosted by Star Trek series luminaries such as George Takei, Jonathan Frakes and Marina Sirtis, and which she has performed under the baton of Maestro Jack Everly. Kristen has also appeared in many musicals with theaters throughout the country, such as *West Side Story*, *Oklahoma!*, *A Little Night Music*, *Carousel*, and other timeless classics.

Sue Anderson's career has been full and varied, ranging from Broadway productions to films to recordings. As a conductor and musical director, Ms. Anderson has worked with the Broadway and national touring companies of *Pirates of Penzance*, *Me And My Girl*, and *Cats*. She played in the orchestra pits of *Chitty-Chitty-Bang-Bang* and *Woman In White* and is currently playing in Spamalot. She has conducted Pops concerts with the Milwaukee, Detroit, Phoenix, Portland and Shreveport orchestras and most recently conducted the London Philharmonia at Abbey Road Studios. An accomplished pianist, Ms. Anderson was the featured on-stage pianist in Broadway's *Jerry's Girls*. She also performs regularly at Carnegie Hall with the all-state choirs produced by Field Studies International.

Irish born Multi Instrumentalist/Singer Songwriter **Gabriel Donohue** is based in Philadelphia. He performs mostly on guitar and piano but also plays many more instruments from bouzouki/mandolin to Irish and exotic percussion. Gabriel performs throughout the USA, solo and along with a cadre of top flight musicians. He toured for three years with the Grammy Award winning *Chieftains*. He has recorded with the Boston Pops, Eileen Ivers, Joanie Madden, James Keane, Sean Quinn, Brian Conway, John Whelan, Karen Mal, Aoife Clancy, Liam Clancy, to name a few. He also produces and engineers albums for a broad array of artists at *Cove Island Productions* in center city Philadelphia. A state of the art facility using top quality microphones and gear. The lists of artists he has collaborated with, is a who's who of the top musicians in the acoustic and celtic music field. He performed with *Michael Flatley* at the *National Heritage Awards in Washington DC*. And played with Eileen Ivers at the Clinton Whitehouse entertaining Irish and American dignitaries and signers of the Good Friday peace accords.

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
