The evening culminates in a grand, collective celebration. As the bells ring out the audience is invited to join the cast in singing Auld Lang Syne.

It is more than a performance, it is a bridge between the old year and the new, a festive embrace of tradition, and a reminder that no matter how far we travel, the heart always finds its way home for the holidays.

Highlights from the Show Program

The Heart of the Highlands

A lone piper plays a haunting, slow-tempo fragment of "Auld Lang Syne," which gradually builds into a cinematic, full-ensemble overture. Echoes of Auld Lang Syne and Silent Night fill the air (Instrumental)

Welcome to Scotland / Highland Cathedral / Come Along

A high-energy transition from the overture into the vibrant spirit of the country. This begins representing the transition from the cold outside to the warmth of a festive home.

The Traveler's Tale

Loch Lomond

The full cast brings the house down with a rousing, sing-along arrangement.

The Tradition
